## Preface

As reported in the “Methodological Guide for Data Collection” (Euromountains, June 2006), the theme 2 concerns the role of territorial authorities and councils to develop natural and cultural heritage and the agro food and craft products in mountain areas, in integrating the data on the general climate for public/private cooperation.”

The implementation of the data collection has followed 6 steps

After clarification of the organisation of authorities and councils in the Provincia Autonoma di Trento (PAT) and identification of the administrative territories of the public bodies and authorities within PAT involved, fourth cases have been collected, aiming to give the most complete territorial and entrepreneurial image of the area and looking to different ways pursued by provincial authorities in supporting innovation. Traditional agro-food products, a recent but consolidated tourism-service linked to traditional mountain houses and an innovative products linked to forest-wood chain have been selected.

Each product/service has been identified and described as well as projects that allowed to reach the final results. Key factors have been studied and described within the framework of the intervention of the provincial involved authorities. The evaluation of intervention of the provincial authorities by involved organisation has been collected, too.

The case studies from Provincia Autonoma di Trento have been carried out by Gian Antonio Battistel, who is researcher at Agenzia per la Garanzia della Qualità in Agricoltura (AQA), has written the general parts of the report which include the area and product descriptions as well as supervised the work. Fabio Romagnoli, who worked as assistant researcher at AQA, has done the field work and performed the analysis of the particular cases.
